Band Director's Report: Dr. Gage

Marching Band captainship tryouts are going on now for next year. Conducting tryouts were this week. Candidates also taught lessons. Next week those in the running will have to teach a drill on the back field.

The Marching Band is invited to the next Board of Ed meeting (December 9) to be honored for a successful season. However, there is a Girls' Club mandatory Candy Cane police meeting at 7:00 pm. Not certain yet whether band will go to Board of Ed meeting afterward or wait until January.

Recruitment performance at RAS may be next Wednesday. MS concert band goes to RAS along with the Marching Band. 5th and 6th graders attend. Each captain speaks about their section. The band performs the entire show, stands and pep music at the end.

Next Friday 12/13 possibly announcing next year's show right after school as well as student leadership perhaps.

Pep Band info was sent out on Classroom as an assignment for students to confirm commitment to the schedule and order a Polo Pep Band shirt. The commitment is for a minimum of 3 out of 5 rehearsals and 7 out of 11 performances. Pep Rally + 5 Girls' Games and 5 Boys'. 4 games are double headers. Pep Band season spans from 12/19 to 2/20 - 2 months - games are very spread out. Working on a modest drum riser and the band set up in front of that.
